## 1. Introduction

This Utility Statement report has been prepared by Waterman Building Services in support of a new detailed application for the continued use and operation of the Sevington Inland Border Facility (IBF), Ashford, TN25 6GE (hereafter referred to as the Site) on behalf of Department for Transport (DFT), His Majesty's Revenue & Customs (HMRC) & Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra).

This document has collated the existing utility services associated with the Sevington Inland Boarder Facility site. The information of the utility services was procured by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party company known as Groundwise Searches Limited.

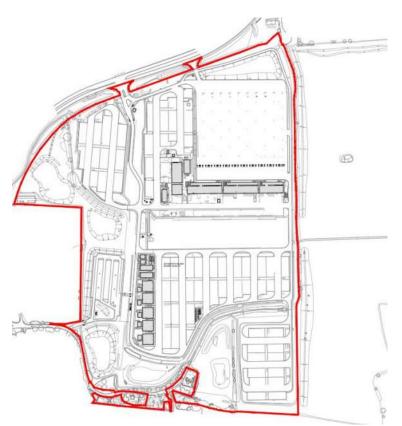
Based on the nature of this application, a fibre to premises statement is deemed not to be required.

#### 1.1 Site Description

The Application Site is centred on National Grid Reference TR 03976 40758 and is located within the administrative boundary of Ashford Borough Council (ABC) and Kent County Council (KCC).

As illustrated in Image 1, the Application Site is located in Sevington, south-east of Ashford in Kent, Postcode: TN25 6GE. This is a semi-rural area on the outskirts of Ashford, with a mixture of residential and commercial land uses located to the north and west of the Application Site but with greenfield land use to the south and east.
